## This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students at or above the NAPLAN National Minimum Standard in Reading.
- Increase the percentage of students at or above the NAPLAN National Minimum Standard in Numeracy.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving a 'C' standard or above in English.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving a 'C' standard or above in Mathematics.
- Support the whole school introduction of the Reboot program across Prep to Year 10.
- Increase whole school attendance to 95%.

## Our initiatives include

Engaging in the purchase of an additional teacher to support the following initiatives:

- embedding the consistent delivery of the whole school approach to Reading;
- embedding the consistent delivery of the whole school approach to Numeracy in line with North Coast Region (NCR) team;
- further implementation of the Reboot Program in collaboration with the NCR cluster;
- teaching practice informed by research and data analysis through the Numeracy and Literacy coaches.

## Our school will improve student outcomes by

Employing an additional teacher in the primary school to support the curriculum initiatives across the college	<b>\$78,000</b>
Employing additional hours for the numeracy coach to support the ongoing NCR numeracy initiative	<b>\$ 3,500</b>
Employing additional teacher aide hours to focus on the priority learning areas of Reading and Numeracy	<b>\$10,000</b>
Providing opportunities for staff to be upskilled in Reboot across the whole school	<b>\$ 2,500</b>
Providing continued opportunities to deepen staff knowledge of Australian Curriculum Assessment and Reporting Authority (ACARA) with the Numeracy coach and the Literacy coach across our two priority learning areas – Reading and Numeracy – for coaching, modelling and reflective practice	<b>\$ 1,956</b>
