This funding will be used to

- Increase the percentage of students at or above the NAPLAN National Minimum Standard (NMS) in Reading.
- Increase the percentage of students at or above the NAPLAN NMS in Numeracy.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving a 'C' standard or above in English.
- Increase the percentage of students achieving a 'C' standard or above in Mathematics.
- Support the introduction of New Pedagogies for Deep Learning across selected Key Learning Areas to improve engagement in classrooms.
- Support the introduction of the Reboot program in selected classes.
- Increase the attendance rate to 95%.

Our initiatives include

- Embedding the consistent delivery of the whole school approach to Reading.
- Embedding the consistent delivery of the whole school approach to Numeracy in line with the North Coast Region team.
- Piloting of New Pedagogies for Deep Learning in line with the North Coast Region cluster.
- Implementation of the Reboot Program in collaboration with the North Coast Region cluster.
- Teaching practice informed by research and data analysis through the Numeracy and Literacy coach.
